PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property existed within the Counties of Riverside, San Diego, and Santa Cruz as a result of a sudden and serious gasoline shortage and having been requested by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors of said Counties, proclaimed a State of Emergency to exist in San Diego County on May 8, 1979; Santa Cruz County on May 9, 1979; and that portion of Riverside County described in my Proclamation of May 11, 1979, as amended May 18, 1979, and June 22, 1979.

Having now been advised by the Chairpersons of the Boards of Supervisors that the conditions of extreme peril no longer exist within Riverside, San Diego, and Santa Cruz Counties, and at the request of the Boards of Supervisors, I therefore proclaim that the State of Emergency within Riverside, San Diego, and Santa Cruz Counties no longer exists, effective 0001 hours, October 6, 1979.
