PROCLAMATION


I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property existed within the County of San Mateo as a result of a sudden and serious gasoline shortage and having been requested by the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors of said County, proclaimed a State of Emergency to exist in San Mateo County on May 9, 1979.

Having now been advised by the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors that the conditions of extreme peril no longer exist within San Mateo County, and at the request of the Board of Supervisors, I therefore proclaim that the State of Emergency within San Mateo County no longer exists, effective 0001 hours, November 1, 1979.
