

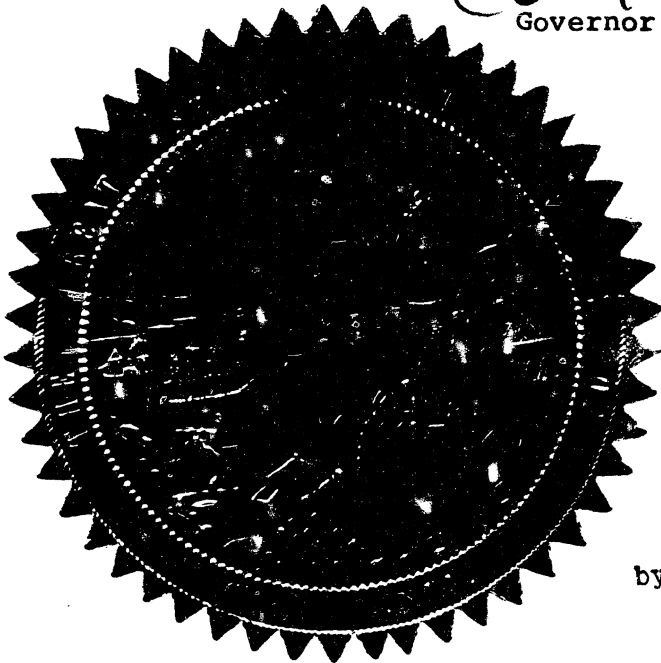
WHEREAS, I have been informed that subsequent engineering surveys have shown that substantial damage to public highways and other property also occurred in the County of Inyo on September 9 through 11 and September 22 through 25, 1976, caused by the same storms, resulting in the Board of Supervisors of the County of Inyo proclaiming an Emergency in said county,


