WHEREAS, agriculture is California's number one industry, providing jobs and leading the nation with an estimated \$14 billion in gross farm receipts; and

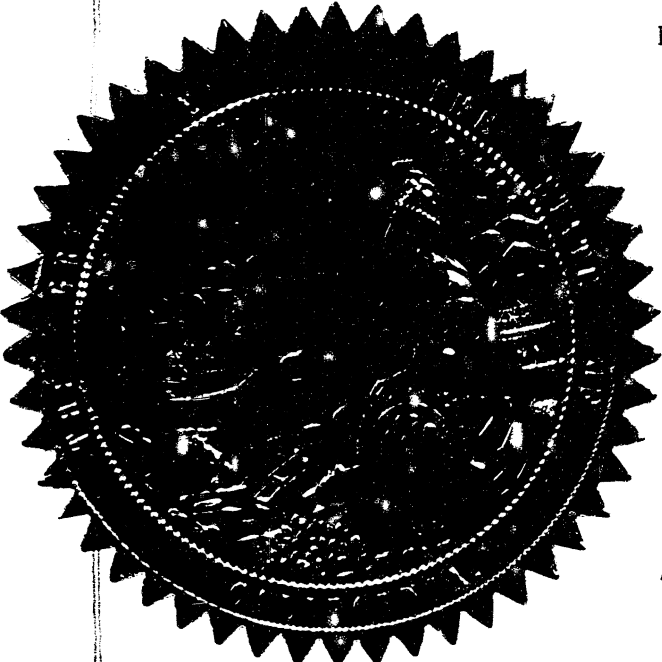
WHEREAS, the financial and political impact of California agriculture extends far beyond the borders of the state having a significant effect on the entire nation's balance of trade; and
