**PROCLAMATION
OF
STATE OF EMERGENCY**

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, having been informed of a catastrophic failure which occurred on April 7, 1982 to the Caldecott Tunnel, a section of Route 24, 6.2 miles east of Oakland in the Counties of Alameda and Contra Costa, State of California, hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the Counties of Alameda and Contra Costa, within the meaning of Section 125, Title 23, United States Code.
