**MEDITERRANEAN FRUIT FLY**  
**EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION**  
**AMENDED ORDER NO. 2**

This amended order is based on the Amended Proclamation of A State of Emergency dated August 25, 1981 concerning the infestation of the Mediterranean fruit fly in the Counties of Alameda, San Benito, Santa Clara, San Mateo, Santa Cruz, and Stanislaus, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and Government Code Section 9646(d).

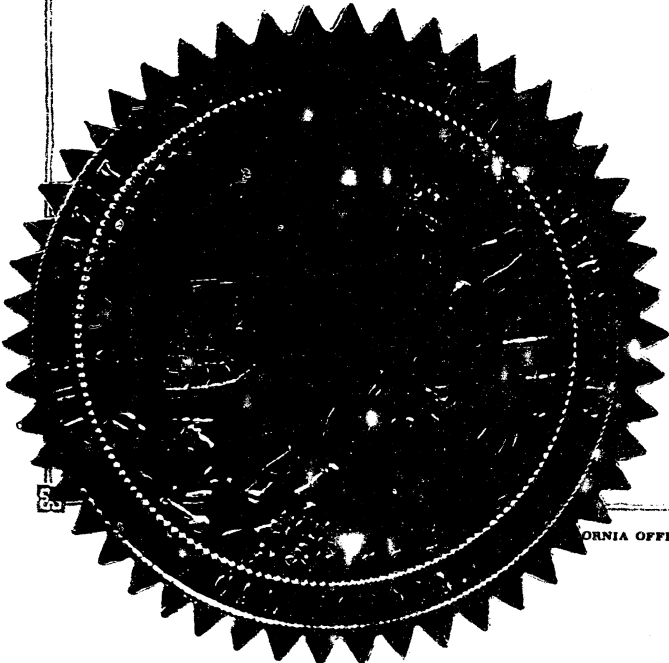
The boundary of the quarantine area is amended to read as follows:

The entire counties of Alameda, Santa Clara, San Mateo and Santa Cruz, and those portions of San Benito and Stanislaus Counties described as follows, within which the Mediterranean fruit fly is known to exist, are hereby proclaimed to be a quarantine area with respect to said pest.

San Benito County. That portion of San Benito County north of a line extending from the junction of the San Benito-Merced-Fresno County lines on the east, extending due west to the San Benito-Monterey County line.

Stanislaus County. That portion of Stanislaus County within the area enclosed by a line beginning at a point where the San Joaquin River meets the San Joaquin-Stanislaus County line; southeast along the San Joaquin River to Hills Ferry Road; southwest along Hills Ferry Road to Stuhr Road (County Route J 18); west along Stuhr Road to Interstate Route 5 and continuing approximately 4 miles west of Interstate Route 5 to Orestimba Creek; northwest, paralleling Interstate Route 5, to the San Joaquin-Stanislaus County line at a point 4 miles southwest of Interstate Route 5, northeast along the San Joaquin-Stanislaus County line to the point of beginning.
