Executive Order B 64-80

WHEREAS, Chapter 656 of the Statutes of 1979 provides that specified employees of the California State University and Colleges who are members of the Public Employees' Retirement System or the State Teachers' Retirement System are eligible to receive additional service credit upon a finding that such credits would be in the best interest of the State; and

WHEREAS, Due to the impending curtailment of and/or change in the manner of performing services resulting from decreased public revenues the Board of Trustees of the California State University and Colleges has recommended that the provisions of Chapter 656 of the Statutes of 1979 be implemented; and

WHEREAS, minimizing the number of mandatory transfers, demotions and layoffs will avoid unnecessary economic and social hardships for employees of the California State University and Colleges and the State itself; and

WHEREAS, any reduction in employees will allow for a vigorous affirmative action recruitment program which will serve the social and economic interests of the citizens and the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby find and declare that because of an impending curtailment of and/or change in the manner of performing service the best interests of the State of California would be served by implementing Chapter 656 of the Statutes of 1979 authorizing additional service credit for specified employees of the California State University and Colleges.
