PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the City of Arvin, State of California, beginning on December 20, 1977, as a result of high winds, blowing dust, and other conditions which, by reason of their magnitude have caused the City to lose its electrical power and water supply and have disrupted transportation and communications systems and are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said City, and having been requested by the Mayor of the City of Arvin to proclaim a State of Emergency in said City, I therefore proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the City of Arvin; and

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
