EXECUTIVE ORDER B-52-79

WHEREAS, the federal government and the California Legislature, through the introduction of H.R. 12428 and S.C.R. 61, respectively, have acknowledged the need to develop both a federal and state-wide plan to fully utilize nutrition research and technology to benefit all citizens; and

WHEREAS, S.C.R. 61 specifically calls for the creation of a state-wide task force above the departmental level to develop a state-wide plan to utilize nutrition research and technology; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order D-2-78 established the California Commission on Food and Nutrition within the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, said Commission having already commenced operation under the direction of the Lieutenant Governor's Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

1. Executive Order D-2-78, as amended December 5, 1978, is rescinded.
2. The California Commission on Food and Nutrition, as established pursuant to Executive Order D-2-78, effective August 27, 1978, shall be under the jurisdiction of the Office of Lieutenant Governor.

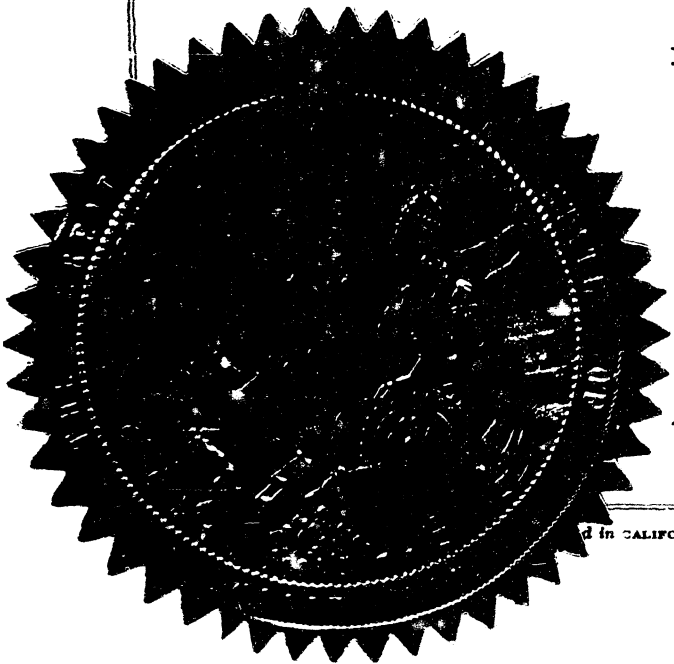
