PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, having found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exist within the County of El Dorado, State of California, beginning on or about September 16, 1979, as a result of forest fire, and other conditions which, by reason of their magnitude, were beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of said County, and having been requested by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County to proclaim a State of Emergency in said County, I therefore proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and hereby implement the California Peacetime Emergency Plan in the County of El Dorado; and

I DIRECT that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
