EXECUTIVE ORDER B 63-80

WHEREAS, timely and accurate data is essential in measuring the health of the people in California, planning and evaluating health programs needed by the citizens of this state and providing appropriate health services; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 95-623, enacted by the United States Congress on November 9, 1978, provides for a Cooperative Health Statistics System under the auspices of the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and requires each participating state to designate a single agency responsible for administration of the state's statistical activities under the System;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

1. A consortium of the directors of the Department of Health Services, the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development and the California Health Facilities Commission is designated as the single state agency required by Public Law 95-623 with responsibility for administration of statistical activities within California under the Cooperative Health Statistics System.
2. The Department of Health Services' Center for Health Statistics shall be directly responsible for administering this program in accordance with the consortium's policy directives.
