PROCLAMATION

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, pursuant to Section 2553 of the Elections Code and Chapters 1 and 9 of the Statutes of 1980, hereby proclaim and order that a special election be held on the third day of June, 1980, to be consolidated with the direct primary election to be held on that date. The following measures proposed by the Legislature, together with three initiative measures will be submitted to the qualified voters of the State of California on that date:

PROPOSITION 1 PARKLAND AND RENEWABLE RESOURCES INVESTMENT PROGRAM. Provides for a bond issue of \$495,000,000 to be used for this program.

PROPOSITION 2 VETERANS BOND ACT OF 1980. Provides for a bond issue of \$750,000,000 to provide farm and home aid for California veterans.

PROPOSITION 3 STATE CAPITOL MAINTENANCE. Restricts authorizations for alteration or modification of historically restored Capitol building and furniture.

PROPOSITION 4 LOW RENT HOUSING. Eliminates present prior election approval for such state public body projects. Substitutes public notice and referendum procedure.

PROPOSITION 5 FREEDOM OF PRESS. Prohibits contempt citation against news media employee for refusing to disclose information or sources.

PROPOSITION 6 REAPPORTIONMENT. Repeals, amends, and restates provisions of Constitution relating to reapportionment of Senate, Assembly, Congressional, and Board of Equalization districts.

PROPOSITION 7 DISASTER ASSISTANCE. Permits governmental aid to persons in removing debris from private property in Presidentially declared major disasters or emergencies.

PROPOSITION 8 ENERGY FACILITIES. Legislature may authorize state revenue bonds to finance alternative energy source facilities and lease or sell these facilities.

PROPOSITION 9 TAXATION. INCOME. Provides that personal income taxes shall not exceed 50% of 1978 rates. Exempts business inventories from property taxation.

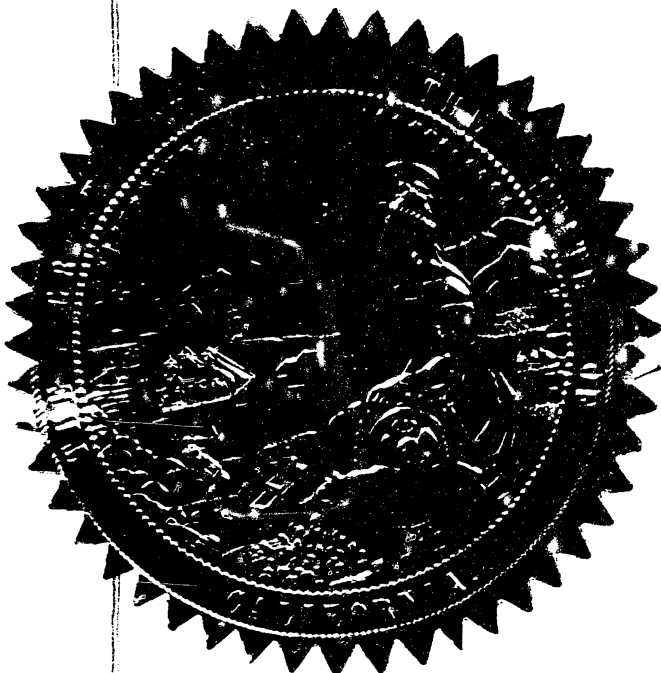
PROPOSITION 10 RENT. Permits rent control only by voter approved local ordinances. Permits annual increases pursuant to specified standards.

PROPOSITION 11 TAXATION. SURTAX. Levies 10% surtax on California oil companies business income to fund alternative services--fuels. Allows investment tax credit.
