EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B-44-78

WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 13 has substantially limited the amount of tax revenues available to cities, counties, school and other special districts; and

WHEREAS, increased financial assistance from the State may be necessary to enable local officials to maintain those services necessary for the protection of public health and safety as well as the continued operation of programs mandated by state and federal laws; and

WHEREAS, the exact amount of State assistance required is unknown at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

1. Effective today, no new employees will be hired by any state agency or department unless
 - a. the appointment was effective on or before June 6, 1978; or
 - b. the position is necessary for the care or supervision of individuals in a 24-hour care facility; or
 - c. the new position or replacement of an existing position is required by an emergency situation or by extraordinary circumstances.

2. The Department of Finance is hereby directed to issue guidelines and instructions necessary for the implementation of this Executive Order.
