PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY


I, Edmund G. Brown, Jr., Governor of the State of California, having been informed that a catastrophic failure has occurred, beginning on or about January 18, 1981, to a portion of the coastal highway known as Mattole Road, FAS Route V058 at approximately post mile 24.2, as a result of high winds, heavy seas and high tides that caused severe damage to said road, hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Humboldt within the meaning of Section 12.5, Title 23 of the United States Code.
