MEDITERRANEAN FRUIT FLY
EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION AMENDED ORDER NO. 2

This amended order is based on the Amended Proclamation of A State of Emergency dated August 13, 1981 concerning the infestation of the Mediterranean fruit fly in the Counties of Alameda, Santa Clara, San Mateo, and Santa Cruz, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and Government Code Section 9646(d).

The boundary of the quarantine area is amended to read as follows:

The entire Counties of Alameda, Santa Clara, and San Mateo, and that portion of Santa Cruz County described as follows, within which the Mediterranean fruit fly is known to exist, are hereby proclaimed to be a quarantine area with respect to said pest:

Santa Cruz County. All of Santa Cruz County north and west of State Highway Route 17 running from the Santa Clara County line south to State Highway Route 1 thence east to Soquel Creek thence south to the Pacific Ocean.

The provisions of this order prohibiting the transportation of any Mediterranean fruit fly host out of the quarantine area except in accordance with regulations promulgated by the Director of Food and Agriculture are amended to read as follows:

No person shall transport any Mediterranean fruit fly host either out of or within the quarantine area except in accordance with regulations promulgated by the Director of Food and Agriculture (Mediterranean Fruit Fly Interior Quarantine). Any person who refuses or willfully neglects to obey any such regulations shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment for not to exceed six months or by both such fines and imprisonment.

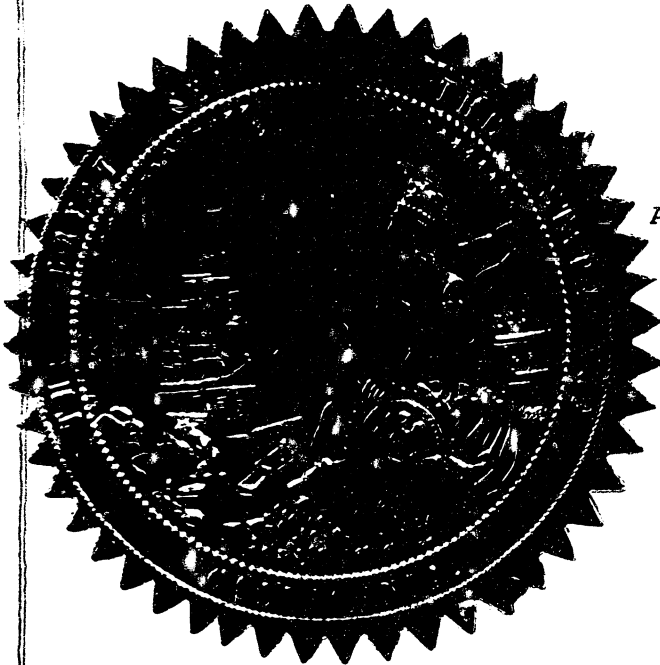
The provisions of this order requiring all persons residing within the quarantine area to remove all Mediterranean fruit fly hosts from trees and plants on their property by a date certain are hereby terminated effective Sunday, August 16, 1981.

The following provision is hereby added to this order:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, members of the California Highway Patrol operating with inspectors employed by the California Department of Food and Agriculture or United States Department of Agriculture,

may within the quarantine area or counties adjacent to the quarantine area, stop any vehicle for the purpose of determining if such vehicle contains Mediterranean fruit fly host.
