**AMENDED
EXECUTIVE ORDER B 20-76**

WHEREAS, California has one of the highest unemployment rates in the nation; and

WHEREAS, public service employment programs under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) of 1973 were created to provide temporary and permanent employment with special consideration provided to veterans, welfare recipients, and severely disadvantaged persons; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable titles and amendments of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act, including Titles I, II, III, and VI, prime sponsors are authorized to enter into subgrants and contracts with the State of California to establish applicable employment programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

I

All State departments participate to the maximum extent feasible in employment programs under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act by providing both permanent and temporary jobs to unemployed persons with special consideration to be given to veterans, welfare recipients, and severely disadvantaged persons; and

II

Individuals employed to perform services in these public employment programs under CETA for agencies of the State of California, may be appointed by the Governor of California or by departments under the civil service system; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

III

The State Personnel Board is authorized to coordinate and manage public service employment programs under CETA for all jobs in State departments through June 30, 1976; and

IV

Effective July 1, 1976, Employment Development Department shall coordinate and manage public service employment programs under CETA for all jobs in State departments; and

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V

As of April 1, 1976, Employment Development Department shall be responsible to actively seek and negotiate available funds from CETA prime sponsors and the Department of Labor for public service employment programs; and

VI

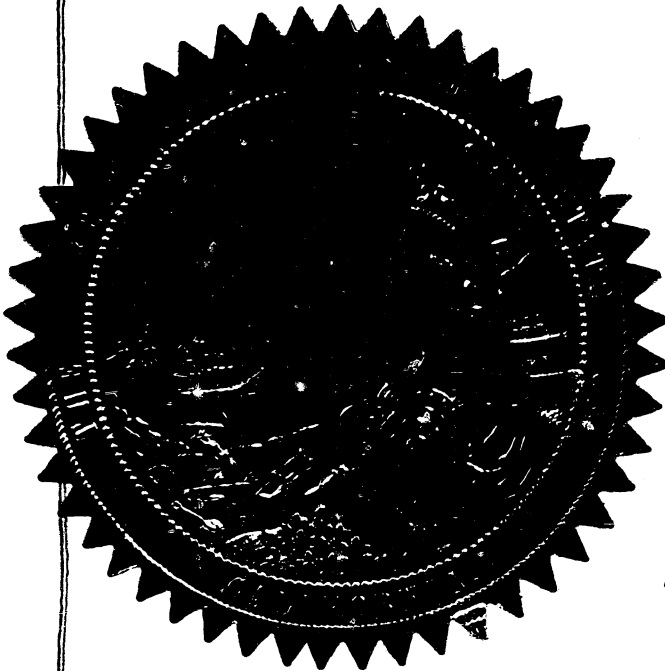
The Coordinating Office for Public Service Employment is established within the Governor's Office and is authorized to provide for administration of the employment processing for appointments of the Governor of California under public service employment programs; and

VII

The Executive Officer of the Coordinating Office for Public Service Employment is authorized to exercise the power to execute any necessary appointment documentation and the administration of the oath of office for the purpose, and to the extent only of the administration, of employment programs under the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 and the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act; and

VIII

That authority under Executive Order B 1-75 is hereby cancelled.
