AMENDING
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California,
proclaim as follows:

That the conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property prevailed at the time of the previous proclamation of May 11, 1979, as pertains to all that portion of the County of Riverside lying westerly of the westerly line of the following Townships and Ranges: Township 2 South, Range 12 East; Township 3 South, Range 12 East; Township 4 South, Range 12 East; Township 5 South, Range 12 East; Township 6 South, Range 12 East; Township 7 South, Range 12 East; Township 8 South, Range 12 East; S.P.B. & M.; and

That it was proclaimed that a State of Emergency existed in the described area.

I now find, at the request of the Board of Supervisors, it is necessary to amend the May 11, 1979 Proclamation of a State of Emergency to realign the boundary to now be that portion of Riverside County lying westerly of the westerly line of the following Townships and Ranges: Township 2 South, Range 12 East; Township 3 South, Range 12 East; Township 4 South, Range 12 East; Township 5 South, Range 12 East; and Township 6 South, Range 12 East; thence west along the southerly line of Township 6 South, Range 11 East; Township 6 South, Range 10 East; Township 6 South, Range 9 East; Township 6 South, Range 8 East, until arriving at the southwest corner of Township 6 South, Range 7 East; thence in a southerly direction along the westerly line of Township 7 South, Range 7 East; Township 8 South, Range 7 East, to the San Diego County border, S.B.B. & M.

This amendment effectively excludes the area around the north end of the Salton Sea, including the community of Mecca.

I hereby incorporate, by reference, the regulations pertaining to the California Gasoline Emergency filed with the Secretary of State on the 15th day of May, 1979, and all subsequent amendments thereto and issue these regulations pursuant to Section 8567 of the California Government Code. These regulations shall apply to the amended area of Riverside County in which a State of Emergency exists.

I direct this program shall begin at 0001 hours, May 20th, 1979, in the amended area of Riverside County.

I direct that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.
