I. INTRODUCTION

Petitioner Jon Vranesh ("Vranesh") brought this petition for writ of mandate on September 17, 2015, challenging the Commission on Professional Competence's ("Commission") unanimous decision to dismiss Vranesh from his employment with the Pleasanton Unified School District ("District").

Later, Vranesh served Real Parties (collectively, "the Board") with formal interrogatories and requests for admission, despite the fact that discovery is presumptively unnecessary in administrative mandate actions, as such actions typically proceed solely upon the administrative
