

June 8, 2010 California Library Ballot Measures*

Library ballot measures bat 100% with four parcel taxes passing and one general sales tax measure being approved on the June primary ballot.

Los Altos & Los Altos Hills (North County Library Authority)

Santa Clara County Library Special Tax	Parcel Tax Operations	Passed 76.6% of Yes Vote*

Measure L was a \$76 per year parcel tax for library operations for 20 years.

Marin County

Marin County Free Library Special Tax	Parcel Tax Operations & Facilities	Passed 74.0% of Yes Vote

Measure A is a \$49 per year parcel tax that will restore the materials budget, fill vacant staffing hours, do critical maintenance and ADA improvements as well as generally maintain services.

San Anselmo

San Anselmo Public Library Special Tax	Parcel Tax Operations & Facilities	Passed 74.4% Yes Vote

Measure B was a \$49 per year parcel tax for library operations which will allow the library to hire staff to have more open hours, improve children's services and buy new computers and more materials.

San Rafael

San Rafael Public Library Special Tax	Parcel Tax Operations & Facilities	Passed 69.0% of Yes Vote

Measure C is a \$49 per year parcel tax which sunsets in 7 years will maintain current levels of library services, and restore some recent cutbacks.

Woodland

Woodland Public Library General Tax	Sales Tax Operations	Passed 55.2% Yes Vote

Measure V is a ¼ cent sales tax general tax that may be used for library operations among other city services. The measure will sunset in four years.

****General tax ballot measures and Gann overrides in California require a simple majority (50+%) to pass, but library special tax measures require a 2/3's supermajority to pass.***
