Position Overview and Impact:

To meet the growing demand for quality storytimes; volunteers will be trained to assist library staff in planning for and performing storytimes. Also, storytime conductors will be trained to perform their own storytimes.

Key Responsibilities:

Gather materials and help staff in set up and take down storytimes
Assist staff in signing up children for storytimes
Assist staff in performing storytimes
Perform assigned storytimes

Provide a much needed service to the library

Qualifications:

Upbeat friendly demeanor
Love working with children and parents
Familiarity with children's literature
Good organizational abilities
Comfortable with public speaking and singing, particularly in front of young children
Minimum age is 18

Training and Support Provided:

Orientation to the library system and story time activities
Story telling training workshops
Assigned mentor
Access to staff as needed for problem solving

Time Commitment: Minimum one scheduled shift per week during storytime cycle. A shift is usually one hour.

Time Duration: 6 months—one year
