Sacramento – The nonpartisan *Easy Voter Guide*, a publication of the Easy Voter Project managed in part by the California State Library, provides clear descriptions of each state proposition in plain language, short statements from the candidates and helpful information for new and busy voters. Highlights of the Easy Voter Guide Project include:

- *Candidates for President* section that explains the duties of each elected office and provides personal statements and photos from each candidate

The Easy Voter Guide Project is partnering with public libraries, newspapers, county elections offices, high schools, community colleges, adult schools and churches to distribute over 1 million *Easy Voter Guide* booklets in five languages. *Easy Voter Guide* distributors include the Asian Pacific American Legal Center, the National Organization of Latino Elected Officials and the PICO California North Valley Sponsoring Committee.
