You will need to sign up for our DVS service before requesting videos. You need a television with DVD player or a computer with a DVD player to watch descriptive videos on DVD.

This catalog is yours to keep and lists all DVD titles by subject. Included at the end of this catalog is a mail order form that lists DVD titles alphabetically. You may also order DVDs by phone, fax, email, or in person.

Each video in this catalog is assigned an identifying number that begins with "DVD". For example, DVD 0096 is a DVD entitled "Jack and the Beanstalk."

*When you insert a DVD into your player, the movie will either begin with descriptive narration automatically OR you may have to use visual menu navigation. The films that do ***not*** begin automatically with descriptive narration are marked with an asterisk (*) before the movie title. The descriptive narration track is usually found under Languages or Set-up menus.
