Annual Update | 2022-2023

The California State Library awarded and administered* over \$840 million in grant funds during the 2022-2023 fiscal year, helping California libraries, cities, counties, universities, and non-profits develop new services, expand successful programs, and provide Californians with equitable access to the resources we all need to succeed.

The State Library's grant programs and initiatives gave children and teens access to free meals, academic tutors, and after school activities. They provided adults with literacy programs, career services, and digital navigators to help them use and access new technologies. And they gave all Californians access to trusted news and information sources, high-speed broadband, bookmobiles, new and improved library buildings, free passes to state parks, and archived collections of photographs, film, newspapers, and manuscripts documenting the state's history, art, and cultures.

Here we tell the stories of just a few of the programs and initiatives that are serving Californians from Siskiyou County to San Diego, Monterey County to Mono. Please head to the end of the report for a full list of our grant programs, initiatives, and awards.

The California State Library is a champion and supporter of local libraries and trusted steward of state and federal funds. The Library Development Services team helps local libraries meet the needs and expectations of California's communities and improve access to opportunities for all.

The California State Library's grantmaking helps local libraries better meet the needs and expectations of California's communities and improve access to opportunity for all.

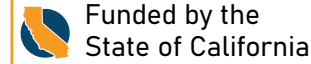

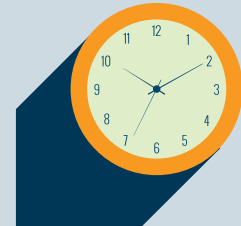

Building Equity Based Summers

In partnership with the California Library Association



The “Building Equity Based Summers” project was created by the California State Library and California Library Association in 2020 to provide library staff with training, resources, and tools to help them deliver truly equitable summer services and programs for and with community members. The project helps libraries better focus on

marginalized youth and families that have historically not connected with summer library services.

Local library staff create a shared understanding of equity to analyze traditional summer programs and build new summer services that meet their communities’ needs and aspirations. They tackle the challenges associated with changing long-term practices, growing new mindsets, and moving beyond a one-size-fits-all approach to library programming. The project helps library staff connect with underserved youth and families so that these community members feel fully represented in library summer services. Changes made by library staff who participate in Equity Based Summers harness the strengths of their local communities.

Participants have co-designed a set of Quality Principles and Indicators that identify key areas library staff must address to build equity-based summer services with benchmarks set to better measure success in each area.

“The communities served by Kern County Library are diverse and include often-marginalized groups, such as communities of color, non-English speakers, and those of lower socioeconomic status. Building Equity Based Summers in California was awarded a federal grant in 2022 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. The California Library Association received a Laura Bush 21st Century Librarian Program grant for a three-year project to expand to other states, including Connecticut, Idaho, Maryland, Ohio, Rhode Island, and Washington. The library association and the California State Library will work with state and local libraries to re-envision summer practices and co-design equitable summer services nationally, partnering with WebJunction, a library training organization, to share resources, activities, and best practices among library staff nationwide.

There are 48 library systems across seven states and 117 library staff members currently participating in the Building Equity Based Summers initiative.

Building Forward



The Building Forward Library Facilities Improvement program continues to help California cities and counties renovate, revitalize, and build new libraries for their communities. Building Forward is the largest single investment in local public libraries ever made by the State of California.

Round One awards were announced in October 2022. More than \$312 million was awarded to 246 individual library facilities in 182 cities across 34 counties. Projects in high-poverty areas of the state that addressed life-safety and critical maintenance and infrastructure needs were prioritized. Local jurisdictions are contributing nearly \$180 million in matching funds.

The first set of Building Forward awards spanned the length of the state, from Shasta County Library in the north to San Diego Public Library in the south. Projects that received the greenlight include upgrades and repairs to 17 library branches in Kern County, a new, safe library building for Larkspur;

upgraded energy efficiency systems in Shasta County; seismic repairs and upgrades in Sonoma County; a new jurisdiction-wide security system for Los Angeles County Library's 86 branches; and a new multimedia center in San Diego.

The awarded funds will also build seven new libraries to either replace outdated, unsafe buildings, or create new library service areas. The City of Porterville received \$7.3 million to help construct a new library building after its library was destroyed by fire in 2020.

In October 2023, California State Librarian Greg Lucas announced the second round of awards for the Building Forward Library Facilities Infrastructure Grant program. In this round, 34 local libraries are scheduled to receive more than \$172 million to address critical maintenance needs, improve energy efficiency and sustainability, and expand digital and physical access in 29 cities across 18 counties. Seven new library buildings were approved for construction, 27 libraries will make energy efficiency upgrades, seven libraries will expand or redesign spaces for public programming, and 12 libraries will repair critical roof, foundation, or exterior building issues.



Sustainable California Libraries

Local libraries are uniquely positioned to help communities become more resilient and sustainable. Libraries are community hubs that deliver trusted information. They're at the heart of community networks and they provide resources and programming for people of all ages.

The Library Development Services Bureau developed the Sustainable California Libraries initiative in 2022 and awarded \$475,500 in federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds for sustainability projects in 19 local communities.

Library staff, partners, and community members collaborated to develop teaching gardens; offer hands-on, outdoor, intergenerational programs; facilitate community conversations; and create lending libraries for tools and seeds. Libraries partnered with local Native American communities, Offices of Sustainability, and Climate Action Planning teams.

The State Library also hosted a Sustainability Symposium which was attended by 99 library workers and partners and made available online for others to view later. Twelve presentations by library staff showcased success stories, celebrated partnerships, and shared promising practices from California libraries. In Year Two, the initiative will support 15 more projects that focus on climate education, civic engagement, water conservation, air quality, energy efficiency, reducing waste, and supporting local climate action and resilience plans. A second symposium is scheduled for May 2024.





Ready or Not Disaster Preparedness

In partnership with the Northeast Document Conservation Center and Myriad Consulting & Training Inc.

The State Library is helping to ensure that California’s cultural heritage is protected and preserved for the future. In November 2022, the Library partnered with the respected [Northeast Document Conservation Center](#) to help communities develop plans to protect their at-risk collections from natural and manmade disasters.

The California State Library’s [Cultural Collections Protection Survey](#) was completed by more than 400 California archives, historical societies, libraries, museums, and tribal nations in 2021. Survey results showed that approximately half of respondents lack disaster response plans, a significant concern given the risks posed by fire, flood, and earthquakes, and threats from inadequate storage facilities and simple decay over time.

The [Northeast Document Conservation Center](#) is working to assist local archives, historical societies, libraries, museums, and tribal nations in creating customized disaster preparedness plans. A team of heritage preservation consultants had conducted on-site visits for 92 organizations by June 2023 and continue to do more. Their reports document each organization’s current state of emergency preparedness and include recommendations for mitigating risks, taking emergency preparedness actions, and completing a disaster plan.

Next steps for Ready or Not include a grant program in partnership with Myriad Consulting & Training Inc. to provide organizations with the tools and resources they need to implement their disaster preparedness plans and protect and preserve their culturally significant collections.





CAreer Pathways

In partnership with the Pacific Library Partnership

California's public libraries are helping to create a future-ready California workforce by providing communities with CAreer Pathways digital resources. These resources help Californians earn professional certificates, prepare for exams, write resumes and cover letters, and take courses in digital literacy, business, plumbing, law enforcement, graphic design, management, and more.

94 percent of learners surveyed would recommend a CAreer Pathways learning resource to a friend, colleague, or family member, and Californians have told us:

"I got my High School Certificate through the library. I have also taken several LinkedIn courses on a variety of topics. As an immigrant, these have become an invaluable source of tools to first, improve my English skills, then advance my career. I have nothing but good experiences. Thanks!" – Adult Learner, Orange County

"My husband was unable to get a job with the degree he had as it had components that were out of date. When I found this resource was free through the library, we signed him up. He completed five different certificates and was able to find a job! His employer mentioned that the certificates were what got him the job as it taught him the updated skills he needed. We wouldn't have been able to complete courses without the library as we couldn't afford it." – Adult Learner, Fresno County



The CAreer Pathways program aligns with California's State Digital Equity Plan and the mission of California public libraries, by ensuring all Californians have access to free digital skills training, upskilling, and the educational resources they need to succeed in the digital age. The State Library is collaborating with the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, the California Department of Aging, and other community-based organizations to ensure all Californians seeking training and resources know about this opportunity.



Stronger Together and Shared Vision

In partnership with the Black Gold Cooperative Library System and Califa Group

The Stronger Together and Shared Vision grant programs support libraries in developing partnerships and expanding access to library services. The State of California's investment of \$16 million in these two programs has supported over 100 new library access projects focusing on early learning and after-school services, library vehicles, and new technologies.

Early learning projects such as kinder-readiness workshops, parenting classes, and new spaces for children and caregivers to play and learn are providing families with essential services and strengthening the library's role as a community hub. Ventura County Library is working with its local First 5 California agency to offer developmental screening and referrals to help families meet basic needs. Redwood City Public Library supports families with children identified with ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder) and other learning differences and provides sensory-friendly storytimes at the library and in the community. Inyo County, Oakland, and Oceanside libraries have designed after-school programs focusing on science exploration, art, and library internships, helping children and teens develop social-emotional and workforce readiness skills.

Other libraries are expanding access to library services, both after hours and outside the library walls, through new vehicles, systems, and technologies. Solano County residents now use book lockers to access materials when the library is closed. In Merced County, the new bookmobile brings computer stations to rural residents who don't have easy access to library branches. In another 14 cities and counties, libraries have implemented the Open+ technology system which allows residents to access library buildings outside of staffed library hours.

When all the library access projects are completed, over 30 new mobile libraries will be traveling throughout California—with 24 using alternative sources of energy such as solar and electricity—and over 20 libraries will have improved customer service and expanded library access through book lockers or the Open+ access system.





California Library Literacy Services and AmeriCorps

In partnership with the Pacific Library Partnership

California's library literacy programs grew significantly this year thanks to an investment by the State of California in English-as-a-Second-Language services in public libraries. Over 10,500 adult learners enrolled in library literacy services—up from 6,900 last year—and received almost 300,000 hours of tutoring and other live instruction free of charge. Libraries also delivered family literacy programs for about 9,000 adults and 15,000 children.

The State Library awarded \$10 million in grant funds to 104 California Library Literacy Services programs in the 2022-2023 fiscal year. Library literacy services are provided for low-literacy adults and their family members by trained volunteer tutors and staff. They are based on a one-to-one tutoring model and focus on the goals set by individual learners.

Increased English-as-a-Second-Language services, supported by a one-time, five-year investment of state funds, are helping libraries engage with more community members and address vital needs. About 44 percent of Californians speak a language other than English at home, and half of those speak English “less than well.” In 2021, 26.5 percent of California's population was foreign-born, more than twice the level in the rest of the country, and more than a third of adults of prime working age (25-54) are immigrants. About half of all children in the state have at least one parent who is an immigrant.

for promoting social cohesion and community engagement by providing trainings, field trips, and learner leadership programs for over 1,300 learners and tutors.

Although their program year just ended, half of the AmeriCorps members will continue volunteering or working for pay in their library's literacy program. The AmeriCorps Initiative was managed by the Pacific Library Partnership and the nonprofit Literacyworks. It was paid for in part through the California State Library's Literacy Initiatives project.

A statewide AmeriCorps initiative also made a difference to California's library literacy programs this year by deploying 50 service members at 25 libraries across the state in a mix of full, half, and quarter-time positions.

In addition to tutoring and leading classes for over 3,000 learners, AmeriCorps members helped libraries add new services by leading English-as-a-Second-Language and citizenship groups, book clubs, conversation groups, virtual classes, and family literacy services.

As part of their mission to strengthen library literacy programs, these members recruited 2,042 new adult learners and 659 new volunteer tutors. They far exceeded their planned goals

"An immigrant from Afghanistan, who recently earned his own US citizenship, showed his dedication to his community by becoming a full-time AmeriCorps member in Stanislaus County. He tutored many students and helped them improve their education, build English skills, and reach personal goals. He aided two of his students, also Afghan immigrants, to achieve their life goals: improve their English, pass the DMV test, and get a job. Now these students have steady incomes that directly impact themselves, their family, and their community. Both learners credited their success to their enrollment in the tutoring program and to their dedicated tutor." – Literacy staff, Stanislaus County

"A literacy participant at Contra Costa County Library came to the U.S. in 2022 fleeing the war in Ukraine with her 11-year-old son. She had studied English in Ukraine and had intermediate level reading and writing skills, but her speaking skills were basic. Over the course of nine months working with her tutor, she has been able to get a job at a day care center. By practicing dialogues and vocabulary with her tutor she has become increasingly comfortable with talking to the parents at her work. She chose to take the driver's license exam in English and passed."

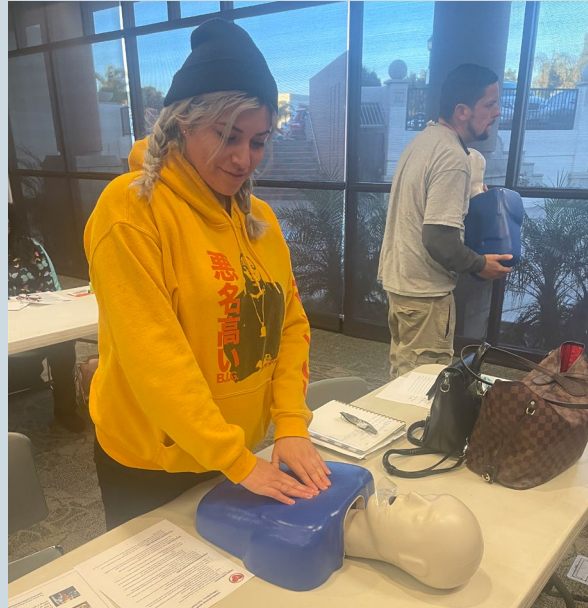

- **Get Involved** – Training, networking, and resources to help libraries engage skilled volunteers and build effective volunteer programs. *In partnership with Califa Group.*

- **Inspiration Grants** – Grants to help library staff respond to “a-ha moments” and implement innovative projects when inspiration strikes.
- **Local & Collaborative Grants** – Grants to help California libraries design equitable programs and services in collaboration with their local communities.
- **Sustainable California Libraries** – Grants to help libraries design programming and educational opportunities focused on sustainability and climate resilience.

- **Digital Navigators** – Support for Californians in using technology devices, accessing online workforce development and digital literacy tools, and connecting to resources for low-cost internet services. *In partnership with the Southern California Library Cooperative*
- **eBooks for All California** – A shared eBook collection for all California public library users. *In partnership with the Black Gold Cooperative Library System.*

- **High-Speed Broadband for California Public Libraries** – Broadband access for Californians through their local library, and grants that support and expand broadband connectivity in libraries. *In partnership with CTC Technology & Energy and Califa Group.*
- **Lunch at the Library** – Summer meals and learning and enrichment programs for children and teens. *In partnership with the California Library Association.*
- **Parks Pass Program** – Parks Passes and state park public programs for Californians at their local library. *In partnership with the California State Parks Department and the Office of the First Partner of California.*
- **Zip Books** – Books requested by library patrons delivered directly to their homes.



Infrastructure

- **Building Forward Library Facilities Improvement Program** – Grants to address life-safety and critical maintenance needs of public library facilities and build new libraries throughout California.

- **Targeted State Grants** – Grants for libraries, museums, and cultural institutions that received funding for special projects in the California state budget.



Libraries & Library Workers

- **California Libraries Learn (CALL)** – In person and virtual continuing education and training opportunities, including webinars, courses, workshops, conferences, and self-paced learning, for library staff. *In partnership with the California Library Association.*
- **California Library Services Act** – Support for cooperation and resource-sharing among California’s nine regional cooperative library systems. The program is administered by the 13-member California Library Services Board.
- **Literacy Initiatives** – Support and training for library literacy staff, volunteers, and learners. *In partnership with the Pacific Library Partnership.*
- **Networking Library Resources** – Support and opportunities for the library community and library leaders to share

information, ideas, and resources statewide. *In partnership with the Pacific Library Partnership.*

- **Public Library Staff Education Program (PLSEP)** – Tuition reimbursement for California library staff pursuing a master’s degree in library and information science. *In partnership with all California Cooperative Library Systems.*



Protecting and Celebrating California’s History and Culture

- **California Civil Liberties Program** – Grants to help organizations create and disseminate educational and public awareness resources about the history and lessons of civil rights violations or civil liberties injustices carried out against communities or populations.
- **California Digital Newspaper Project** – A growing repository of historical California newspapers published from 1846 to the present.
- **California Humanities** – Humanities-based projects and programs, eye-opening cultural experiences, and meaningful conversations.
- **California Revealed** – Support for public libraries, archives, museums, historical societies, and other heritage groups to digitize, protect, and provide online access

to primary source materials documenting the state's history, art, and cultures. *In partnership with Califa Group.*

- **LGBTQ+ Preservation and Accessibility** – Grants to help organizations preserve materials relating to the LGBTQ+ movement, culture, experience and/or history in California.
- **Oral History Project** – Preservation of oral histories related to California government.
- **Ready or Not Cultural Heritage Disaster Preparedness Project** – Consultation and grant funds to help organizations protect and preserve California's cultural resources and heritage. *In partnership with the Northeast Document Conservation Center and Myriad Consulting & Training Inc.*
