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Executive Summary

The Building Forward Library Facilities Improvement grant program is the largest single investment ever made by the State of California in its network of 1,127 local public libraries.

This equity-based grant program prioritizes improvements to public library facilities in California's poorest communities. Projects address life safety and critical maintenance needs, improve energy efficiency and sustainability, extend digital access, and expand physical access to library facilities. The Building Forward funds have been both a lifesaver and a game changer, according to feedback from California cities and counties.

A total of \$489 million was allocated to the Building Forward program across two fiscal years. These funds support projects that address life safety and critical maintenance needs, improve energy efficiency and sustainability, extend digital access, and expand physical access to library facilities. The State Library administered program funds in two rounds. During each round, applications were reviewed by a panel of external advisors whose names and affiliations are included in Exhibit B. Round One awards were announced in October 2022 and Round Two awards were announced in October 2023.

The State Library has funded 279 projects. These projects are improving existing libraries and building new local libraries in 201 cities across 39 counties. A full list of projects is available at the end of this report in Exhibit A.

The \$489 million in state funding, plus the \$260 million contributed locally by grantees, will address less than 20 percent of the \$4 billion in repair, modernization, expansion, and replacement needs of California's library facilities.

Equity Strategies

In accordance with the direction of the Legislature, high poverty areas of the state were prioritized during both rounds of funding.

The State Library used the California Poverty Measure (CPM) to assess poverty at a community-based level. The CPM is jointly produced by the Stanford Center on Poverty and Inequality and the Public Policy Institute of California. According to the California Budget and Policy Center, when examining poverty levels within regions or counties in California, the CPM is preferred because it accounts

for California-specific factors when measuring poverty, such as geographic differences in housing costs and consideration of the availability of food stamps and other non-cash benefits as resources available to families.

According to the CPM data at the time the awards were made, 11.7 percent of Californians live below the poverty line. Eighty-eight percent (249) of Building Forward awards went to facilities in communities experiencing poverty at a higher rate than the statewide rate. Fifty-four percent of grants (151) were awarded to facilities in communities experiencing high poverty rates, ranging from 20 percent to 52 percent.

Round One Awards

Eighty-six of California's 186 library jurisdictions submitted applications for 278 individual buildings in Round One. Individual grant requests ranged from \$14,300 to \$10 million, the maximum allowable award per facility. The average request was just under \$2 million. Project requests ranged from new roofs and HVAC replacements to the construction of new library facilities.

Over \$312 million was awarded to benefit 244 individual library facilities in Round One. Funded projects include HVAC system upgrades and repairs, roof replacements, expansions, renovations, and new library buildings, including a new building for the City of Porterville whose library was destroyed by fire in 2020. As part of the grant program requirements, local jurisdictions are contributing nearly \$180 million in matching funds.

Round One awards benefit 182 cities across 34 counties from Shasta County in the north to San Diego in the south. Funded projects include updates and repairs for 17 library branches throughout Kern County; seismic strengthening for the San Benito County Free Library: a new building for the Archibald Branch Library in Rancho Cucamonga to accommodate community growth; vital upgrades to the HVAC, fire suppression in the City Heights Annex of the San Diego Public Library System; and a jurisdiction-wide security system for Los Angeles County Library's 86 branches.

Awardees have until March 31, 2026, to expend their funds and complete their projects.

To date, four of the 244 projects funded in Round One have been completed. These communities are Alhambra, Del Mar, Riverside, and San Leandro. Project funds supported the replacement of inadequate HVAC systems, outdated fire control panels, leaky roofs, and roof gutter systems.

Round Two Awards

In Round Two, more than \$172 million was awarded to 34 local public libraries to address critical maintenance needs, improve energy efficiency and sustainability, and expand digital and physical access in 29 cities across 18 counties. Applications were received from nearly half of the 186 public library jurisdictions in California. Local library jurisdictions will contribute a minimum of \$80 million to

the projects through program mandated local match funds.

Awards were made in October 2023. These awards will enable seven communities to build new libraries, 27 libraries to make energy efficiency upgrades, seven libraries to expand or redesign public programming spaces, and 12 libraries to repair critical roof, foundation, and exterior building safety issues.

Some examples of funded projects include:

 Construction of a replacement library facility for Contra Costa County's Bay Point Branch, which will be a part of a mixed-use and transit-oriented development;

- Repair of the City of Oakland's historic Carnegie library (Melrose Branch) to address significant foundation issues while preserving the facility's historic elements;
- Creation of a reliable cooling center at the City of Hemet's public library;
- Replacement of windows and doors at the City of Brawley's library, built in 1935, to improve safety and energy efficiency;
- Installation of air conditioning in Ventura County's Main Library, which will enable the facility to open as a cooling center during weather events; and
- Updating all essential building operational systems at the City of Santa Ana's Newhope Library Learning Center.

Round Two grant awards ranged from \$13,200 to \$10 million. Grantees have until March 31, 2027, to expend grant funds and complete their projects.

Additional Need

The total estimated cost to address California's statewide public libraries' infrastructure and capital project needs is over \$4 billion, far exceeding the \$489 million appropriated by the Legislature for the Building Forward Library Facilities Improvement grant program.

Although 279 projects were awarded grant funds through Building Forward, 104 projects totaling over \$276 million remain unfunded from Round Two applications. The State Library is holding the remaining applications

and is ready to immediately greenlight more projects if additional state funds become available. These unfunded applications include projects in 87 cities and 32 counties.

Libraries have broader capital needs than are addressed through the parameters of the Building Forward program. Among these needs are a shortage of library buildings and spaces relative to the local population, outdated digital modernization, and facilities improvements in library jurisdictions that did not have the resources or ability to apply for Building Forward grant funds during the open application period.

Based on data from the annual Public Libraries Survey and other individual surveys conducted by the State Library, the average age of library facilities in California is 50 years, with only 5 percent of buildings constructed in the last decade and only 19 percent remodeled in the last decade.

Libraries are essential spaces where Californians gain free access to educational resources, literacy services, and technology they may not be able to purchase themselves, including computers, hotspots, and high-speed broadband. However, many California libraries report failing building systems and a lack of upgrades, as well as the need to replace, expand, and reconfigure space to accommodate growing populations, deliver advanced library services, and address their communities' changing priorities and needs.

Failures and shortfalls in the facilities that provide communities with essential early learning opportunities, tutoring for children and teens, health and wellness resources, social spaces for clubs, and community meetings, limit the number of people who can access these vital community services and resources, and potentially expose users to uncomfortable, inaccessible, and unsafe environments.

Legislative Policy Considerations

California public libraries have projected that the total amount needed to upgrade facilities statewide is more than \$4 billion—eight times the \$489 million allocated for the Building Forward grant

program. Various options are available to meet this ever-growing need for capital improvements to public library facilities.

Options include:

- Increasing state funds available for Building Forward grants so that more projects can be greenlighted.
- Placing a statewide general obligation bond measure of \$799 million on the ballot. Combined with the investments already being made through Building Forward and the local funding match, this would address nearly half of the over \$4 billion in modernization, renovation, and replacement costs identified by the state's public libraries.
