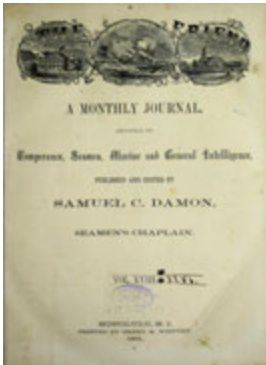

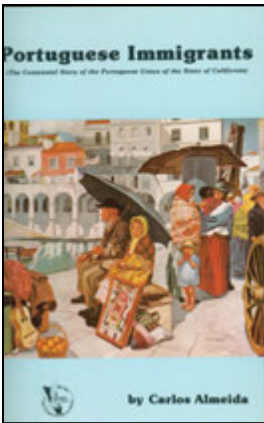
Graves, A. (2004). [The Portuguese Californians : Immigrants in agriculture.](#) San Jose: Portuguese Heritage Publications of California.

An early Portuguese language newspaper filled with news of interest to the Portuguese-American community in San Francisco and Alameda, this is an excellent primary source.



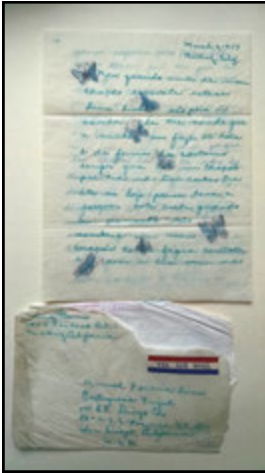

Separate from our photo collection, our postcard collection contains a number of images of Portuguese Americans. Most are not online.



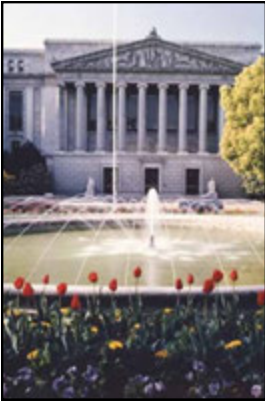
