Can't come to the library just yet? No worries! There are a number of online resources you can explore related to wine in California!



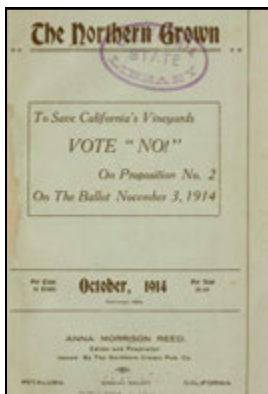

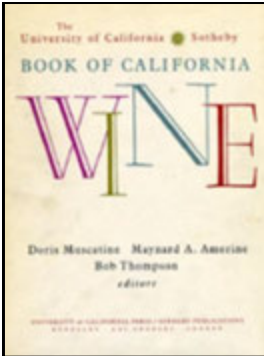

Unsure about where to start? Consult a book! If you are interested in the history of California wine, these items will point you in the right direction.



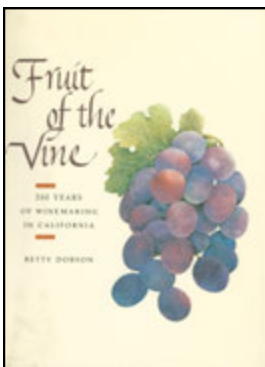

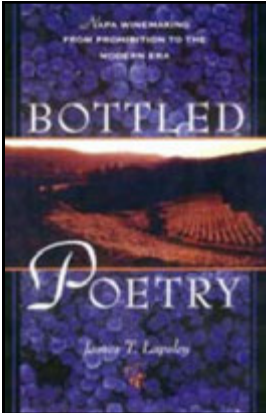
An informal and highly approachable overview. This book provides a general history of wine-making in California from its beginnings through to the 1970s.

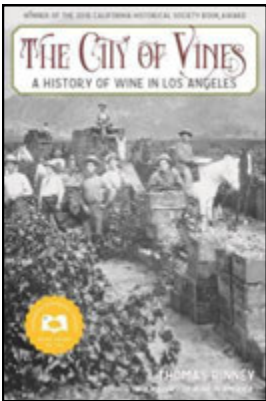

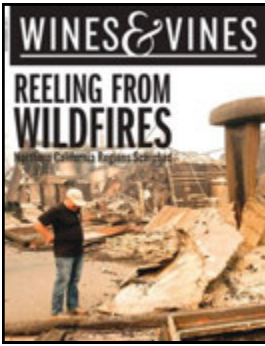

Postcard Files

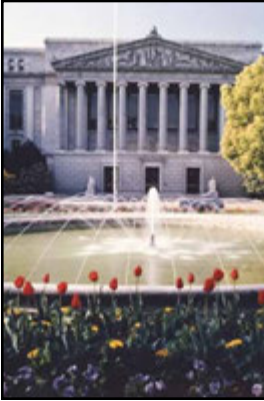
Separate from our photo collection, our postcard collection contains a number of images related to wine. Most are not online.
